Originally a fish-packing operation, the harborside landmark grew into a stand and then a restaurant, about 1958. Try: steamed lobster, raw bar, fish and chips.

Luncheonette, restaurant, ice cream parlor, and good at each. Try: house-made ice cream, sundaes, malteds, BLT, cheeseburger.

It all began in 1932 and has grown since. Try: breakfast dishes, brisket, fried chicken.
